ORDINANCE 2010-11
Adopted March 16, 2010

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF A PORTION OF VILLAGE PARK DRIVE TO ADVENTURE PARK DRIVE.

WHEREAS, Village Park Drive within the City of Powell is split into two sections that are not connected due to the establishment of Adventure Park; and

WHEREAS, the northern portion of Village Park Drive runs through a portion of the Wolf Commerce Park where Powell businesses receive customers and deliveries; and

WHEREAS, a name change to the southern portion of Village Park Drive, as shown on "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference, will provide clarification; and

WHEREAS, this request was discussed by and received the recommendation of the Powell Development Committee; and

WHEREAS, City Council is satisfied there is good cause for the change of street name.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That the portion of Village Park Drive that commences at North Liberty Street and serves as the drive for Adventure Park, the Adventure Park Recreation Facility and the Olentangy Swim Association Pool, which portion is depicted on the map attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference, shall be henceforth known as "Adventure Park Drive."

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest period allowed by law.
