ORDINANCE 2010-25

Adopted June 15, 2010

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD A BID TO G. MARCHI & SON, LLC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,242.60 FOR THE 2010 SIDEWALK REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City has received bids from contractors to complete the 2010 Sidewalk Repair and Replacement Program; and

WHEREAS, Council and Staff recommend G. Marchi & Son, LLC as the lowest and best bidder for the above-mentioned project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That Council hereby awards the bid for 2010 Sidewalk Repair and Replacement Program to G. Marchi & Son, LLC and authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City for the purpose of completing the above-mentioned project pursuant to the contract documents.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.


Section 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City and its inhabitants for the reason that there exists an imperative necessity to begin this project during the summer construction period; wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

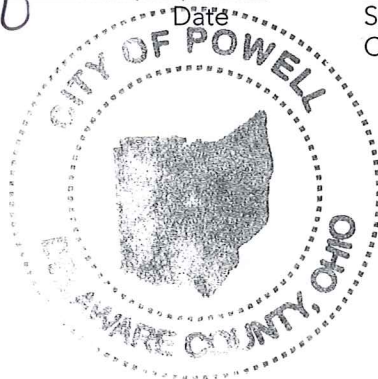


