AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE 2010-56 MODIFYING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2010.

WHEREAS, with Ordinance 2010-56, the Council of the City of Powell reduced appropriations in Debt Service Fund 317 in the amount of \$17,898.62; and

WHEREAS, the modification of appropriations was a duplicate of the actions of Ordinance 2010-48 which was adopted by Powell Council on November 3, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Powell now desires to repeal Ordinance 2010-56.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That Ordinance 2010-56 adopted by Council on December 7, 2010 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: That this ordinance shall take effect on the earliest period allowed by law.


