## Parks and Recreation Summer Program Registration to Begin

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*Powell, OH:* The City of Powell's Parks and Recreation Department has published its Summer 2009 Program Guide, and registration for all warm-weather activities begins soon. Hard copies of the program guide will be published soon; in the meantime, the guide is available online at <http://www.cityofpowell.us/government-parksrec.php>.

Registration for Powell residents begins at 5:30 p.m. on Wednesday, April 22 and runs until 7 p.m. This "express registration" period allows residents to drop off completed registration forms at the Village Green building, 47 Hall Street. Registration for Powell residents continues from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Thursday, April 23. Resident mail-in registrations will be processed after in-person registrations.

Open registration for non-residents will be from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Friday, April 24. Non-resident mail-in registrations will be processed after in-person registrations. As of 8:30 a.m. on April 24, registration will be available through the City of Powell's Web site, [www.cityofpowell.us](http://www.cityofpowell.us).

The Parks and Recreation Department is offering a full slate of classes for all ages this fall, from returning favorites to new programs. Among the programs on this year's schedule are Junior All-Stars (introduces children ages 5-7 to hockey, soccer, basketball and tee-ball), Fun in the Sun (kids ages 3-6 play, learn and create using sand, sun, water and bubbles), Playground Playtime (for moms and their 1-to-5-year-old children), Super Heroes Party (a theme party designed for kids ages 3 to 6), martial arts and King of the Court (a 2-on-2 basketball tournament for grades 5-12 scheduled for June 6 at Olentangy High School), to name a few. Other programs on the summer schedule that promise to be popular are the weeklong summer camps (with several themes from which to choose), a beginner's skateboarding class, babysitters' training, CPR, the annual canoe and fishing trips with members of the Powell Police Department and adult yoga and spinning classes.
