The event is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturday, May 8 in the parking lot of the Municipal Building, 47 Hall St.

"We got a good response to this event last year and decided to have it again," said Jeff Robinson, Powell public information officer. "We've sold close to 30 spaces so far, so it should be even bigger this year."

Participants will each be given two parking spaces in the Municipal Building parking lot where they can spread out their items for sale. Chairs and tables will not be provided. Bargain hunters with nothing to sell are also welcome.

Cost to participate is \$20 for residents and \$27 for non-residents. Admission is free for shoppers who aren't selling.

Those wishing to sell must reserve their space through registration, which can be done in person at the Powell Municipal Building, 47 Hall St., between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Deadline for registration is May 7.
