Powell, OH: In an effort to foster a greater sense of community within the City of Powell's neighborhoods, the Powell Police Department is taking part in National Night Out from 6:30 to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, Aug. 4.

In observance of National Night Out, the Powell Police Department will host an evening of activities at Village Green Park (47 Hall St.). The evening will include a free concert by Six Pack Theory, free Italian ice from Rita's, games, cruiser displays and other activities. The U.S. Marshal's office will be on hand with safety tips and giveaways, and the Delaware County Chapter of the American Red Cross also will have giveaways, including a limited supply of bike helmets.

This is the second year that Powell has been involved with the National Night Out program, a crime prevention event organized by the National Association of Town Watch that promotes police-community partnerships; crime, drug and violence prevention; safety; and neighborhood unity.

"We are encouraging everyone to walk to the event to show that Powell is joined together in helping to keep the community safe," said Powell Police Sgt. Scott Roach. "We are also asking that all individuals turn on their porch lights and leave them on throughout the night."
