The ceremony will take place at 6 p.m. on Friday, April 30 at Village Green Park. The public is invited to attend.

"The Scouts came to us to ask if they could be a part of the ceremony, and we are happy to have them," said Jeff Robinson, public information officer for the City of Powell. "We pushed the time of the program back to 6 p.m. so the Scouts from Pack 428 and their parents could participate. The Scouts have created posters promoting the day and the program, and we have those hanging in the Municipal Building."

The highlight of the ceremony will be the planting of a red maple tree donated by Scott's Garden Center in Powell and the dedication of a placard at the tree planting site. The event also will include opening and closing flag ceremonies and the reading of an official City proclamation. Rita's Italian Ice will provide refreshments for those in attendance.

Earlier this year, the Arbor Day Foundation named the City of Powell a Tree City USA community for the 12th year thanks to the City's ongoing commitment to community forestry.
