Powell, OH: Veterans who have served their country will be remembered and honored during the City of Powell's Veterans Day program, scheduled for 11 a.m. on Nov. 11 (11 a.m. on 11/11/11) at Village Green Park (47 Hall St.). The program is open to the public and attendees are encouraged to bring a small flag or wear something red/white/blue as a show of support. All veterans, their families and friends are invited to attend.

The program, which will take place at the Greater Powell Veterans Memorial, will feature the Franklin Heights NJROTC Honor Guard, vocal and instrumental ensembles from Village Academy School and a military aircraft flyover. In addition, the U.S. Marine Corps will have Toys for Tots boxes and will be collecting new, unwrapped toys to distribute to needy children during the holidays.

"Our Veterans Day program continues to grow. It's become a nice way for us to honor our veterans while raising awareness of the Veterans Memorial," said Powell Public Information Officer Jeff Robinson. "We hope the community will join us on this important holiday."
