Powell, OH: The City of Powell is seeking civic-minded individuals who are interested in giving back to the community to fill vacancies on three City boards and commissions. The City currently has an opening on each of the following:

Planning and Zoning Commission – this seven-member commission reviews all planned development proposals and applications within the City of Powell. The Commission also maintains and adheres to the City zoning code, recommends zoning map changes to City Council and creates long-range and short-term development plans.

Arbor Advisory Subcommittee – this three-member board oversees the coordination of activities and programs that promote Powell as a tree-friendly city.

Tax Incentive Review Council – established under the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code, the Council annually reviews all agreements granting exemptions from property taxation and any performance and/or audit reports required pursuant to those agreements.
