Next Phase of Liberty Street Repaving to Begin Oct. 10

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Powell, OH: The next phase of road work along South Liberty Street is scheduled to begin in October. The work is part of a larger countywide project overseen by the Delaware County Engineer's office.

The project, which includes Liberty Street from the CSX Railroad to State Route 750 (Olentangy Street), is scheduled to begin with pavement planing on Oct. 10. That will be followed by crack sealing (scheduled for Oct. 13), chip sealing (scheduled for Oct. 20), asphalt overlay (scheduled for Oct. 27), berm work (Oct. 28) and striping (TBA). Scheduling is subject to change depending on weather conditions.

Work will be done during daylight hours and traffic will be maintained by a flagger. There will be no road closures or detours during this project.

The project is funded with ARRA federal stimulus funds.
