Liberty Street Work Scheduled to be Completed This Fall

Powell, OH: The first phase of work along South Liberty Street has been completed as part of the City of Powell's 2009 Street Maintenance Program. Resurfacing of that same stretch of roadway is expected to be completed this fall as part of a project overseen by the Delaware County Engineer's office.

The resurfacing project, which includes Liberty Street from the CSX Railroad to State Route 750 (Olentangy Street), is scheduled to be funded with ARRA federal stimulus funds. The project has been submitted to the Ohio Department of Transportation for final review this week before moving on for federal authorization. Once approved, the Delaware County Engineer's office will advertise for bids, with the intent of awarding a contract by late September and beginning work in October.

The scope of the work will be limited to asphalt resurfacing of the roadway and pavement rehabilitation work; there will be no changes to the width of the roadway or shoulder.
