Powell, OH: A Powell subdivision will be making its streets, as well as spirits, bright with its annual luminary display.

The 12th annual Liberty Hills Subdivision Christmas Luminary Display will be unveiled the evening of Saturday, Dec. 20. It will feature more than 1,900 luminaries glowing brightly along sections of Bennett Parkway and throughout the subdivision.

The Liberty Hills Homeowners' Association has observed this neighborhood tradition since 1996. After being on hiatus in 2007, the luminary display, which has drawn visitors from across Central Ohio, returns this year. One hundred homes in Liberty Hills account for 1,600 of the paper lanterns, and the remaining 300 lanterns are set up along both sides of Bennett Parkway between Liberty Road and Shale Ridge Court.

Approximately 20 volunteers, including homeowners' association board members, students from the Olentangy Liberty High School Service Club and local Boy Scouts, help assemble and distribute the luminary kits to all participating homes. Many of the same volunteers bundle up the night of the display and light the many candle wicks tucked inside the luminaries.

Sunday, Dec. 21 will serve as the rain date for the event. Bennett Parkway, which travels through the subdivision, can be accessed from South Liberty Street and East Olentangy Street.
