## City Planning to Add Walkways, More Bricks to Veterans Memorial

*Powell, OH:* The City of Powell plans an addition to its Veterans Memorial this fall.

The Memorial, located at Village Green Park (47 Hall St.), features individual bricks that have been dedicated in honor of local veterans. The City would like to add more personalized bricks to the Memorial, along with north and south walkways leading to the Memorial, in time for a Veterans Day ceremony on Nov. 11.

“We’d like to have some additional brick purchases in the coming weeks, along with some contributions for the south walkway,” said Powell Police Chief Gary Vest, a member of the Greater Powell Veterans Memorial board. “The addition of the walkways is a great enhancement and will provide easier access for persons in wheelchairs or those pushing a stroller.”

Veteran bricks can feature the honoree’s name, branch of service and the name of the war in which he or she fought; a specific achievement; or years of service. Those placing brick orders have three lines for their inscription, with a maximum of 16 characters per line. Cost for ordering a brick is \$100.

The City is planning a Veterans Day ceremony for 10 a.m. on Nov. 11, during which the newly ordered bricks will be dedicated. In order to receive a brick in time for the Nov. 11 ceremony, orders must be placed by Friday, Oct. 16. Order forms and payment, along with contributions for the walkways, can be dropped off at the Municipal Building between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.
