*Powell, OH:* Looking for a fun way to spend your Spring Break? Kids ages 7 to 14 are invited to take part in the Powell Parks and Recreation Department's Spring Break Camp.

The camp runs from March 22-26, dates that coincide with the Olentangy Local School District's Spring Break. Campers will be dropped off at 9 a.m. each day and take part in a variety of fun activities. Each camp day concludes at 4 p.m.

"Our schedule for the week includes a trip to Gameworks, a movie and a lot of Wii and interactive DVD games," said Silas Bowers, assistant director of the department. "We can take up to 24 kids in the camp."

Drop-off and pick-up each day is at the Adventure Park facility on Village Park Drive, with the exception of Thursday, when campers will go to the Municipal Building (47 Hall St.). Thursday's schedule features a day with Powell police officers, who will share their expertise in crime investigation and safety.

Transportation is included for all trips, and lunch is provided Wednesday and Thursday of camp week. Cost of the camp is \$110 for residents and \$117 for non-residents.
