"It's basically a neighborhood garage sale, but it's much more convenient because everyone will be selling their items in one parking lot," said Silas Bowers, Powell Parks and Recreation Department superintendent. Participants will each be given two parking spaces in the Adventure Park parking lot where they can spread out their items for sale. Bargain hunters with nothing to sell are also welcome. Chairs and tables will not be provided.

Cost to participate is \$20 for residents and \$27 for non-residents. Admission is free for shoppers who aren't selling.

This event requires registration, which can be done in person at the Powell Municipal Building, 47 Hall St., between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Deadline for registration is Wednesday, May 13.
