### *Significant Cases for the Month:*

Powell officers took four reports of fraudulent credit/debit card use this month, in the areas of Bettendorf Circle, Shelby Avenue, Muladore Drive and Charterhouse Court. These types of cases are on the rise nationwide, so residents are encouraged to check their bank statements and credit reports frequently and report any suspicious activity to police. With police involvement, most if not all of the victims are able to recoup the loss from their financial institutions.

### *Training*

Total training for the police department in December totaled 19 hours. Officers completed training in Operating a Vehicle Intoxicated (OVI) refresher, Veterans in Crisis, Defensive Tactics and Search and Seizure Updates. For the year, the agency completed 2,426.75 hours of training.


