AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MKSK FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERFORMING PROFESSIONAL DESIGN & PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE DOWNTOWN POWELL STREET SYSTEM IMPLEMENTATION PLAN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Powell Council hereby determines it is in the best interest of the City to proceed with the Downtown Powell Street System Implementation Plan; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the City Manager to enter into such an agreement for such plan with MKSK;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with MKSK, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: That the requirements of Section 133.02 of the Codified Ordinances are hereby waived with regard to professional design services to plan the Downtown Powell Street System Implementation Plan due to the unique experience of the planning and engineering firms relating to this design project, being based upon the recommendations of the Comprehensive Plan.

Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, such emergency arising from the City's desire to commence the planning and implementation of a downtown street system expeditiously; wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
