A RESOLUTION DISBANDING THE ARBOR ADVISORY COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the three-person Arbor Advisory Commission has been responsible for overseeing the coordination of activities and programs that promote Powell as a tree-friendly City; and

WHEREAS, there is no longer a need for this Commission because the duties and activities once handled by this Commission are now handled by Staff and City Council.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City's Arbor Advisory Commission shall be disbanded because the duties once handled by this Commission are handled by City Staff and City Council.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

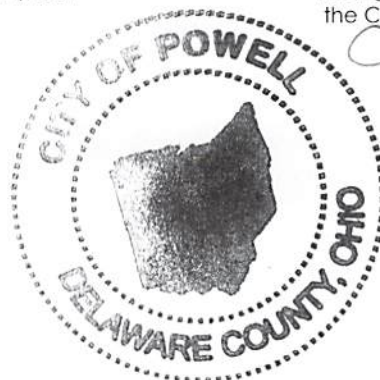
