



RESOLUTION 2022-25

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A DEED OF EASEMENT AGREEMENT WITH CSX TRANSPORTATION, INC. FOR THE PEDESTRIAN TUNNEL

WHEREAS, the City of Powell operates and maintains a pedestrian tunnel on railroad right of way owned by CSX Transportation, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City and CSX previously entered into an agreement for the conversion of bridge culvert no. 148 to the above-referenced pedestrian tunnel; and


WHEREAS, the City and CSX seek to memorialize their respective rights with respect to the pedestrian tunnel by executing a deed of easement for this purpose.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, COUNTY OF DELAWARE, AND STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: City Council hereby authorizes and directs the City Manager to execute and accept a deed of easement for the pedestrian tunnel on behalf of the City of Powell, Ohio. Council further hereby authorizes and directs the City Manager, the Director of Law, the Director of Finance, the Clerk of Council, or other appropriate officers of the City to take any other actions as may be appropriate to implement this Resolution without further legislation being required.




