



RESOLUTION 2022-33

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CENTER FOR PUBLIC SAFETY MANAGEMENT, LLC (CPSM) FOR SERVICES PERTAINING TO A COMPLETE ANALYSIS OF THE POWELL POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Powell, Ohio has identified a need for a staffing and operations assessment to evaluate the City's police staffing and operations approach within the context of workload patterns and trends to determine what opportunities may exist to maximize efficiency and effectiveness of the City's public safety services; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's contracting and fiscal policy, the City Manager seeks legislative authorization to execute an agreement on behalf of the City.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, COUNTY OF DELAWARE, STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City hereby authorized the City Manager or his designee to execute an agreement with the Service Provider on behalf of the City for the service set forth in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 4: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon adoption.
