

## **RESOLUTION 2025-36**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH CIVIL AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONSULTANTS, INC. FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERFORMING PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE SHARED USE PATH AT BENNETT FARM.

**WHEREAS,** the City of Powell Council hereby determines it is in the best interest of the City to engineer the improvements for the Shared Use Path at Bennett Farm Project; and

**WHEREAS,** Council desires to authorize the City Manager to enter into such an agreement with Civil and Environmental Consultants; and

**WHEREAS,** the shared-use plan that is defined in this project is listed as a high-priority project in the City of Powell's adopted Shared Use Path Masterplan; and

**WHEREAS,** the completion of this project would help support the City Council's goal of "Enhancing parks and recreational space and making more bike and walking path connections."

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, COUNTY OF DELAWARE, STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a professional services agreement with Civil and Environmental Consultants, in a form acceptable to the Director of Law, and in a contract amount of approximately \$91,600.00 for professional engineering services related to the design of the Shared Use Path at Bennett Farm Project.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Powell, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon adoption.
