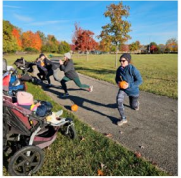

- Registration can be completed and processed online or in person.
- In person registration can take place between 8:30am-4:30pm. Please come prepared with a list of programs you are interested in participating in.
- Class fees must be paid in full at the time of registration. In person registration payment may be made by cash, check, or credit/debit card. Please make checks payable to “City of Powell.”
- Incomplete registration forms, incorrect payment, and/or failure to sign the liability waiver will result in your application being delayed.
- Registrations will be processed in the order they are received. You will be sent a receipt through email.
- Please be aware that enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis.
- We will not contact you to confirm your registration and will contact you only if the class is canceled.

General Information

Photo Release

By registering for, or attending, any City of Powell Parks and Recreation Department program, class, or event, you are agreeing to allow the publication of any photos taken of you and/or your child at any program, class, event or facility of the City of Powell Parks & Recreation Department.

Class Cancellation

The City of Powell Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel classes due to low enrollment and/or other unforeseen circumstances. In the case of a program/class cancellation, you will be notified and issued a full refund in the form of a check or to the credit card used for purchase. Refunds take approximately four weeks to process. When a program/class is canceled due to low enrollment, every effort will be made to notify you 48 hours in advance via e-mail. Prepare to attend each class unless you are notified by a City of Powell employee or the program instructor.

Refunds

Participant-requested refunds are subject to a processing fee. For courses less than \$50 there is a flat \$5 processing fee, and for course fees over \$51 there is a 10% processing fee. Refunds will be granted only when requested no later than five days prior to the first class meeting. Since decisions to maintain classes are based on the enrollment at the first session, no refunds are granted after the first session. In the case of maximum class enrollment or class cancellation, you will be granted a full check refund. Please allow four weeks for processing all refunds. Refunds for camps may incur additional fees. All in person payments will be refunded in the form of a check.

Anticipate to participate. Register early.

Waiting until the last minute could mean the program you are interested in will be canceled. In order for a class to survive, we must have at least the minimum number of registrants 48 hours prior to the start of the first class. Attempting to enroll on the day classes are set to begin will not save the class. PLEASE REGISTER EARLY.

Park Shelters and Athletic Fields

The City of Powell has several areas that can be reserved for community functions. Athletic field and park shelter reservations are available by visiting Powell.RecDesk.com. There is a maximum of two 90-minute reservations per week per group for athletic fields. Park shelters are available on a per hour basis. All reservations are subject to approval by the Parks & Recreation Manager.

Economic Development Efforts Deliver Results



In just its second year, the City of Powell's Economic Development Department is delivering measurable results and meaningful financial returns for the community.

A Year in Numbers

In 2025, the City's Economic Development team managed 402 active projects, a 12.9% increase over 2024. Those projects included business attraction efforts as well as business retention and expansion initiatives. That activity resulted in 30 new businesses or startups choosing Powell, a 170% increase over the prior year. The direct economic impact included:

- 496 full-time equivalent jobs
- \$17.45 million in new payroll
- \$85.25 million in capital investment

In addition, business expansion projects generated 14 new jobs and \$910,000 in additional payroll. Altogether, new payroll in the City of Powell reached \$18.36 million in 2025 alone.

Supporting Existing Businesses

Economic development is not only about attracting new companies. It also ensures that existing businesses have the resources and support they need to grow.

In 2025, the City conducted 166 business retention and expansion visits, 40.6% more than in 2024. These proactive and ongoing efforts help businesses reinvest locally, strengthen the economy, stabilize employment and expand the tax base.

Revenue That Supports City Services

The benefits of economic development extend beyond individual projects. New payroll and the income tax revenue it generates is cumulative, meaning each year's growth builds upon prior gains.

In just two years, the combined efforts of the City of Powell's Economic Development Department and the Powell Development Corporation have generated \$482,200 in new income tax revenue. Those funds support city services, infrastructure and long-term community priorities.

Strategic Investment with Strong Returns

Powell's economic development strategy is intentional and data-driven, with a return on investment that reflects that focus:

- \$628,980 in grants leveraged \$12.12 million in capital investment, representing an 1,826% return on investment
- Overall economic development return on investment reached 1,202.63%
- Tax Increment Financing projects are projected to generate \$5.13 million in payments in lieu of taxes over 30 years (non-school), supporting infrastructure improvements without increasing the residential tax burden

Delivering at a Regional Scale

Compared with surrounding communities, Powell's results meet or exceed regional benchmarks. Achieving this level of impact in only two years underscores the effectiveness of the City's strategy and partnerships.

Growth With Purpose

Economic development in Powell is about more than numbers. It is about strengthening the local economy, reinvesting in the community and ensuring the City has the resources needed to serve residents now and in the future.

Two years in, the results demonstrate clear momentum, and Powell is just getting started. City leaders are encouraged by the progress to date and look ahead to 2026 with optimism, as new projects, partnerships and investments continue to position the community for sustained success.
