- Communicate class needs, supply requests, and schedule updates to the Parks & Recreation Supervisor.
- Provide excellent customer service to participants and families.
- Support departmental programs and events as needed.

Minimum Qualifications

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Experience teaching, coaching, leading activities, or instructing recreational programs is preferred.
- Ability to work independently and lead groups with confidence and professionalism.
- Ability to work a flexible schedule that may include mornings, evenings, and weekends.
- Ability to obtain CPR and First Aid certification.
- Possession of a valid Ohio driver's license and vehicle insurance.
